

CONSTITUTION FLYWHEELS CAR CLUB OF SILVERTON, OREGON

ARTICLE I NAME

This club shall be known as the Flywheels Car Club of Silverton, Oregon. The club colors shall be light blue and white. The club logo includes a fly's head and drag slicks.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The Purpose of the FLYWHEELS is to promote safety; show courtesy on the highway; help persons in distress; contribute to the good of the community; respect at all times all traffic laws; to promote legal dragging; and in general build respect and fellowship between hot rod clubs and the general public. Also to instruct and show the proper method of building and maintaining their cars and to build and maintain Club cars.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

Members in this club shall be granted to those with an interest in our purpose.

ARTICLE IV OFFICERS

The officers of this club shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, a Sergeant-at-Arms, and a Public Relations Officer.

ARTICLE V MEETINGS

SECTION I:

SECTION II:

Annual meetings shall be held on the third Thursday of December unless members are notified before then.

SECTION III:

Special meetings shall be called by the executive committee and must be planned in advance.

ARTICLE VI

This constitution may be amended at any meeting of the organization by a two-thirds vote of the members present. A proposed amendment to this Constitution must be published in the monthly newsletter prior to the meeting of the vote.
